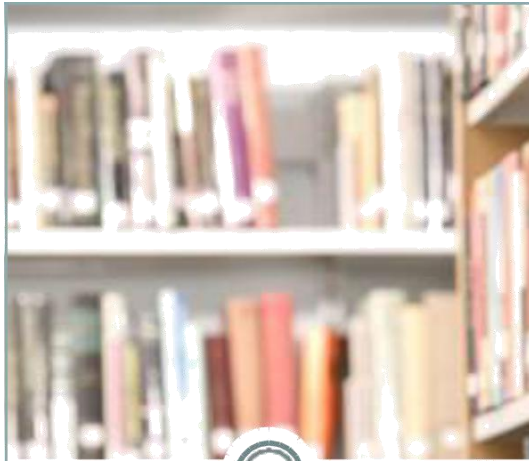

How to Earn Credits for College Degrees While Still in High School

We all know that going to college after graduation from high school can be expensive, so if you could take industry certifications through a Career and Technical Education Program while still in high school and earn credits or clock hours towards an AS/AAS or PSAV Degree why wouldn't you?

TUITION & FEES

The current tuition rate for PSAV (Post-Secondary Adult Vocational) for the 2019-20 SY at Emerald Coast Technical College is \$2.92 per clock hour. The current tuition rate for Advanced & Professional Degrees for College Credit or for Post-Secondary Vocational for College Credit is \$104.01 per credit hour for the 2019-20 SY at Northwest Florida State College.

One example of savings might be if the industry certification earned by the student is equal to 150 clock hours then the student/parent could save \$438.00 on tuition and fees at Emerald Coast Technical College or if the industry certification is equal to 3 (three) credit hours then the student/parent could save \$312.03 on tuition and fees at Northwest Florida State College, as indicated by the tuition rates mentioned above.



CURRENT INDUSTRY CERTIFICATIONS IN WALTON COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Microsoft Office Specialist Bundle or Microsoft Office Master = 150 clock hours at ECTC in Administrative Office Specialist **or** 3 college credits in Office Administration, AAS/AS (*All High Schools*)

MSSC Certified Production Technician = 6 credit hours in Electronics Engineering Technology, AAS/AS **or** 15 credit hours in Engineering Technology, AAS/AS **or** 9 credit hours in Manufacturing Technology, AAS/AS (*FHS Only*)

Adobe Premier certification = 3 credit hours in Digital Television/Media Production **or** 8 credit hours in Radio & TV Broadcast Programming, AAS/AS (*PHS, SWHS & WHS*)

Adobe Certified Associate (Dreamweaver) or (Flash) = either certification would be 3 credit hours in Internet Services Technology. AAS/AS. (*MIC/STEAM Only*)

Autodesk Certified User certification = 3 credit hours, *PLTW Engineering Courses/EOC articulated to Rochester Institute of Technology (MIC/STEAM Only)*

Agriculture Technician Certification = 2 credit hours in Agriculture Production Technology, AS (*PHS Only*)

Agriculture Systems Associate certification (WMS and FMS)

Animal Science Certification = 3 credit hours in Agribusiness Management, AAS/AS (*PHS Only*)

QuickBooks Certified User Certification = 3 credit hours in Accounting Technology, AAS/AS (*SWHS Only*)

Certified Nursing Assistant = 165 Clock Hours towards Patient Care Tech at ECTC. (*SWHS Only*)
