- Each course is worth 60 hours. ESOL Endorsement and courses are considered 'bankable' points by FLDOE. This means if you don't use the points to renew your certificate during the current certification period, you can 'bank' the points for future usage.
- When registering, please make sure the course title begins with WCSD. You will only register in ePDC. You will be placed in the Microsoft Teams on the date the class begins.
- These courses are facilitated by educators in the WCSD. You will receive a welcome email with their contact information and instructions for accessing the course when the course begins.
- Kristy Grey will review the course completion information once each course ends and mark participants complete in ePDC. Please check 2 weeks after the course ends to verify that your course is there.
